Operator Maintenance Tech III

The Port of Corpus Christi Authority is currently accepting applications for the position of Operator/Maintenance Technician III. This position under the direct supervision of an assigned supervisor learns to operate and maintain all material handling systems and associated support equipment at the Bulk Terminal.

Essential Functions:

1. Learns to and operates the Gantry Crane and all related equipment, such as but not limited to learning and performing required maintenance tasks on gantry crane including wire rope replacement and bucket replacement.
2. Learns to and operates the radial ship loader and associated equipment. Assists in performing required maintenance tasks on radial ship loader.
3. Learns mechanical and electrical operating parameters, specifications and working characteristics of the gantry crane and radial ship loader and their related components.
4. Operates all material handling equipment associated with loading and unloading cargo.
5. Operates locomotive and performs all duties associated with railroad operations.
6. Assists in performing all required terminal maintenance and performs all terminal cleaning tasks.
7. Learns to and detects operational malfunctions and assists in performing preventative maintenance.
8. Learns to and troubleshoots/repairs conveyor system malfunctions.
9. Learns to perform arc and mig welding tasks.
10. Performs all required maintenance of support equipment including forklifts, backhoes, locomotives, vehicles, etc.
11. Assists in performing layout, fabrication and fitting of structural and operational components.

Other:

12. Provides assistance to other employees to achieve maximum departmental efficiency.
13. Adheres to Port policy and maintains good employee relations.
14. Drives vehicle as necessary to complete assigned duties and works required hours/shifts necessary to fulfill facility objectives.
15. Performs related duties as assigned.

Additional Physical Factors: While performing essential functions employee is regularly required to stand, walk, reach, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl and sit. Use of hand to finger movements. Frequent lifting and/or moving of up to 10 pounds and occasional lifting and/or moving of up to 25 pounds.

Environmental Factors: Exposure to adverse weather conditions, risk of electrical shock and occasional fumes or airborne particles. Moderate noise levels and moving mechanical parts are present.

Minimum Qualifications: High school diploma or GED equivalent; ability to speak, read and write English; ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules,

operating and maintenance instructions and procedural manuals; ability to perform mathematical computations in all units of measure; ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists; considerable judgment to safely and efficiently operate and maintain equipment; must possess good mechanical aptitude, manual dexterity, depth perception, close, distance, color and peripheral vision, and physical conditioning; ability to work at heights above thirty feet; minimum one year related experience in the operation of heavy mechanical equipment and/or training in the duties outlined above or equivalent combination of education and work experience. Must possess valid driver's license and must be willing to comply with the Wellness Program and Non-Tobacco use policy.

Must possess valid driver's license.
