**SAIL SOUTH TEXAS 2010 WEATHER UPDATE RELATED TO
TROPICAL STORM ALEX**

ALERT # 3 - June 29, 2010 11:00 am CST

CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS - Weather forecasts continue to project landfall for Tropical Storm Alex to be south of the Sail South Texas event site at Ingleside, Texas.

The tall ships are scheduled to depart Veracruz, Mexico today, Tuesday, June 29 in the afternoon with a planned arrival at Ingleside Friday afternoon.

The Thursday Sail South Texas VIP Welcome Event has been cancelled.

The event site will open to the public at 10:00 am Friday, July 2 for the public to view the ships arrival. All event activities, entertainment, jumbotron to watch soccer world cup games and food/beverage vending are planned to be open at this time as well.

Due to the late arrival of the ships, no public tours of the ships will be scheduled until Saturday at 10:00 am. The Friday fireworks have been rescheduled to Saturday at 9:30 pm.

Saturday, the event site will open for business 10:00 am and all event activities and entertainment will happen as planned. Asleep at the Wheel will be the featured entertainment Saturday evening.

Sunday, July 4 all activities will continue as planned including the special Sailors Independence Day Parade at 6:00 pm, the championship Sail South Texas Soccer Cup match at 2:00 and the Fireworks Over the Tall Ships at 9:30 pm.

The SSTX Executive Committee will continue to monitor the weather forecasts for possible revisions to this schedule. Any changes will be promptly posted to www.sailsouthtexas2010.com for public information purposes.
