### **Hurricane BERYL Port Condition Recovery**

**July 8, 2024**

Effective 11:00 a.m. on July 8, 2024, the Captain of the Port (COTP) Corpus Christi has rescinded Port Condition Zulu for the following waterways:

- Intracoastal Waterway from MM 521 near Rockport TX, south to the US/Mexico Border, including Rockport Cut and Lydia Ann Channel.
- Corpus Christi Ship Channel.
- La Quinta Channel.
- Brownsville Ship Channel.

For the waterways listed above, vessels may proceed to facilities and conduct cargo operations.

Remaining waterways in the COTP Corpus Christi Zone will be assessed and reopened when determined to be safe.

All mariners are reminded to use extreme caution when transiting waterways in South Texas as debris and hazards as a result of Hurricane BERYL may be present. All hazards are requested to be reported to the U.S. Coast Guard Sector/ Air Station Corpus Christi Command Center on VHF radio channel 16 or by phone at 1-800-874-2143.
